

Paradise flycatcher, Common Tailorbird, Ashy Prinia, Red Avadavat, Coppersmith Barbet, Red whiskered bulbul, Purple Sunbird, Orange Headed Thrush, Oriental Magpie, Pale billed Flowerpecker, Paddy filed Pipit, Baya weaver, Indian Pitta, Asian Koel, Indian Roller, Rose ringed parakeet, Indian Mynah, Golden Flameback, Rufous Treepie, Greater Coucal, Golden Oriole, Black Drongo, Green Beeater, Yellow Billed Babbler, Jacobin Cuckoo.

3. Water Birds (which include waders, storks and herons):




